



Allow for the issuing, capture and storage of service orders for maintenance work and ensure all spare parts, labour and consumables are linked to the appropriate service order. Check and ensure that appropriate spare parts are available in inventory to complete scheduled service orders.

- Calculate applicable costs per fleet item, fleet group or entire fleet including fuel costs.
- Allow vehicles to be grouped in a variety of ways for analysis such as by vehicle type.
- Manage the lifecycle of the fleet asset from acquisition to disposal. Assist with the calculation of charge out rates by checking recovered charges by fleet group and fleet item.
- Manage and control vehicle regulatory inspections together with driver licenses and health check requirements.

### **Reporting Requirements**

All reports and drill down graphs are custom designed for the client, through the CIP. The following is a sample of the types of management information reporting that would be required for fleet maintenance applications.

- a. Costs by fleet group and individual fleet item with drill down to analyze costs by fuel, lubricants, materials and labour usage.
- b. Vehicles scheduled for service.
- c. Vehicles scheduled for disposal.
- d. Utilization by fleet group and fleet item.
- e. Identify fleet items with missing data (exception report).
- f. Over fueling (exception report).
- g. Excessive fuel usage (exception report).
